- Col 3:1 "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.

 - 4 When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory."

II. BASIS

God's AMAZING GIFT OF SALVATION

- Col. 1:3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, ⁴ since we heard of your **faith** in Christ Jesus and of the **love** that you have for all the saints, ⁵ because of the **hope** laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, ⁶ which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—
- 9 And so, from the day we heard, we <u>have not ceased to pray for you</u>,

asking that you may be **filled** with the **knowledge** of his will in **all spiritual wisdom and understanding**,

10 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord,

fully pleasing to him,

bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might,

for all endurance and patience with joy;

- 12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.
- 13 He has **delivered us** from the **domain¹ of darkness** and **transferred us** to the **kingdom of his beloved Son**, 14 **in whom** we have **redemption**, the **forgiveness** of sins.

III. RESPONSE: CHANGE OUR GARMENTS

- Col. 3:5 <u>Put to death</u> therefore what is **earthly** <u>in you</u>: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. ⁶ On account of these the wrath of God is coming. ⁷ In these you too once walked, when you were living in them.
- ⁸ But now **you <u>must</u> put them all away**: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth. ⁹ Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have <u>put off the old</u> self with its practices
- 10 and have **put on the new** self, which is **being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.**
- 11 Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all.
- Col. 3:12 **Put on then**, as God's **chosen** ones, **holy and beloved**, compassionate hearts [NK] tender mercies], kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,
- 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another,
 - **forgiving each other**; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.
- ¹⁴ And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
- 15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.
- 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom,
 - singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

¹⁷ And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
