# Understanding First Fruits – In-Forming the Future

#### I. Thinking Like God

Wrong Thinking can get us in trouble. We can prime our thoughts toward power and love or toward fear.

The Beggar & the King - "Give me something." Resentfully, the beggar gave the king 2 grains of rice. Then the king reached into a pouch within his robes and with a smile, dropped 2 small diamonds into the beggars bowl.

#### We can mistake an opportunity for a demand.

If we could instruct the future how to treat us, how we would want to live, what we would hope for our children, would we do it?

The beggar could have, but he didn't.

#### **Gideon's Transformation!**

Gideon's initial thoughtst were theat the Lord had abandoned his people.

- Judg 6.11 NLT Then the angel of the LORD came and sat beneath the great tree at Ophrah, .... Gideon son of Joash was threshing wheat at the bottom of a winepress to hide the grain from the Midianites. 12 The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said, "Mighty hero, the LORD is with you!"
- 13 "Sir," Gideon replied, "if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? And where are all the miracles? ... But now the LORD has abandoned us ...."
- 14 Then the LORD turned to him and said, "Go with the strength you have, and rescue Israel from the Midianites. I am sending you!"
- 15 "But Lord," Gideon replied, "how can I rescue Israel? My clan is the weakest in the whole tribe of Manasseh, and I am the least in my entire family!"

- 16 The LORD said to him, "I will be with you. And you will destroy the Midianites as if you were fighting against one man."
- 17 Gideon replied, "If you are truly going to help me, show me a sign to prove that it is really the LORD speaking to me. Mal 3
- 18 Don't go away until I come back and **bring** my offering to you." He answered, "I will stay here until you return."
- 19 Gideon hurried home. He cooked a **young goat**, and ... he baked some **bread** without yeast... and the **broth** in a pot, he brought them out and presented them... 21 fire ... from the rock!
- Gideon could, and he participated in the Divine Nature ... **change!** ... personal, national, & global

#### II. The Potential of a Renewed Mind

Rom 12.2 ESV Do not be conformed to this world, but be **transformed** by the **renewal<sup>1</sup> of your mind**, that **by testing** you may discern what is the will of God, ....

Ps 40.4 **Blessed** is the man who makes the LORD his trust,...

You have multiplied, O LORD my God, your wondrous deeds and your thoughts toward us; none can compare with you!

I will proclaim and tell of them, yet they are more than can be told.

Psa. 139:17 How *precious* to me are your *thoughts*, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

18 If I would count them, they are more than the sand.
I awake, and I am still with you.

## III. 7 Principles <u>FF at the Beginning</u> (Tithe <u>after</u> the Harvest)

1. Given at the Beginning – Through FF we <u>sanctify</u> our whole life and all we love.

- Rom 11:16 NIV If the part of the dough offered as **firstfruits is holy, then the whole batch is holy**; if the root is holy, so are the branches.
- 2. It's a Pattern not Legalism We honor the King of Kings with the First and the Best and He honors us
  - Heb 11:4 *By faith Abel offered God a better sacrifice* than Cain did...And *by faith he still speaks*, even though he is dead.
- 3. Generosity Indicates Grace and Love at Work in our lives
  - 2 Cor 8:7 NIV But just as you excel in everything in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us see that you also excel in this grace of giving.
    8 I am not commanding you, but I want to test the sincerity of your love by comparing it with the earnestness of other

Do you want this GRACE of GIVING?

- 4. We Give According to What We Have. In offerings give part of ourselves— our offerings <u>take us beyond</u> our present circumstances. FEAR NOT!
- 2 Cor 8:12 NIV For if the willingness is there, the gift is acceptable according to **what one has**, not according to **what he does not have**.
- Mark 12:41 NKJ Now Jesus... **saw** (*theoreo*) how the people put money into the treasury. ... 42 Then one **poor widow** came and threw in two mites...

#### Sometimes we think we have nothing, but we actually do

- Elijah & the Widow 1 Kgs 17:9 "Arise, go to Zarephath, ... Behold, I have commanded a widow there to feed you." ... 12 "As the LORD your God lives, I have nothing...
- Our last can be a new FIRST. What we think is nothing, God can make something!

- **Elijah & the Widow** 2 Kgs 4.2 And Elisha ... "What shall I do for you? Tell me; what do you have in the house?" And she said, "...nothing ... except a jar of oil."
- 5. Giving is Analogous to Planting Seeds
- 2 Cor 9:6 NIV Remember this: Whoever **sows**...7 Each man should **give** what he has decided in his heart to **give**, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

### The seed we sow connects our lives to the soil of God's love — and His Great and Precious Promises

- A seed an embryonic information capsule, carrying all the instructions needed for increase and multiplication. A seed is alive and packed with almost limitless potential.
- Seeds are God's "future containers." Seeds contain God's blueprint for the future. Apple seed -- not just an apple, but a tree that gives for years and years!
- **a.** Our children are seeds. The Creator Himself became a seed of His creation and as a seed broke the bondage of decay and released the power of an endless life!
- b. Seeds are part of the **Time Structure** of creation!
- Gen 8:22 "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest,

Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease." NKJV

**c.** Words are Seeds, containing a potential future. Every word contains in a future reality in an immature form:

Luke 8:11 NKJ "... The seed is the word of God.

- d. Offerings are Seeds, containing a potential future. Every offering contains in a future reality in an immature form.
- **6. Receiving is PROPORTIONAL.** (participation)
- Luke 6:38 NKJ Give, and it will be given to you:... For with the **same** measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

This is very personal. The same **measure** I use, is how it is measured back to me!

When I use a teaspoon... 100 Wheelbarrow... 10 Ton Truck ...

Gen 22:16 NKJ and said: "By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son— 17 blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants ...stars... sand; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. 18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

#### 7. Our Giving Releases God's Creative Ability

2 Cor 9:8 NKJ And **God is able** to make *all grace* <u>abound</u> **toward you**, that **you**, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance <u>for</u> *every good work*.

God works with what we <a href="have">have</a>! Don't let what you don't have overrule what you do have! Mustard Seed has all the instructions.

Our sowing can *initiate the Miracle* 

OUR TESTIMONY — 1977 starving ... increased our giving... change began to overtake us. By 1984 built a house w/o debt

#### Be thankful and begin to joyfully use what you do have!

Gen 26:12 NKJ Then *Isaac* sowed in that land, and **reaped** in the same year a **hundredfold**; and the LORD **blessed** him. 13 The man **began to prosper**, and **continued prospering** until he **became very prosperous**; 14 ... the Philistines envied him.

#### IV. 4 Keys to First Fruits:

- 1. <u>Cyclical</u> —Annual basis or at the beginning of a new endeavor.
- 2. **In Faith** –

- a) Comfort you just do it, in the budget, etc.
- b) <u>Faith</u> a stretch to that which is beyond our ability. We increase our "measure"
- c) Presumption— trying to manipulate God
- Sacrificial if it doesn't move you, it probably won't move God.
  - 2 Sam 24:24 ESV "...I will not offer burnt offerings to the LORD my God that cost me nothing." So David bought the threshing floor and the oxen...
- 4. <u>Focused</u> create a list of the areas you are sowing in for breakthrough.
  - a. Reflects the godly passions of your heart
  - b. Based on God's Word.
  - c. Pray, Believe, Decree, Stand. You will reap if you don't faint. You have seed in the ground!
  - d. This is a time to sow, to consecrate the dreams for our lives and the promises of God we hold in our hearts.
- (Anonymous Testimony Last year a man gave a FF offering for the first time. He received an unexpected gift that was 200 times what he had given!)

#### V. Instructions for First Fruits Offering

- 1. Pray for God's Direction (desire discipline delight) Pray for <u>hearing hearts</u>.
- 2. Have a Target, or Ask God for One (Gates held by the enemy)
- 3. Set an amount, or ask for one.

4. Write a check or a pledge (next two months)

No Fear — Refunds for 2 weeks!

5. Bring it on First Fruits Sunday
