## Romans 11- A Future for Israel

## I. Romans – Gospel of the Righteousness of God

### A. Rom 1-8 Gospel Source of Salvation [slide 1]

- Ro 1:5 ... we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the **obedience of faith** for the sake of his name among all the nations,
- 8:39 [Nothing] in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

### B. Rom 12-16 Transformation: Response to the Gospel

Rom 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, ...

#### C. Rom 9-11 The Israel Issue

Israel is the only nation in the world with a complete history—past, present, and future. Yet Paul's experience —> Most Jews rejected, Church becoming predominantly Gentile.

## II. God Rejected Israel? Impossible!

## A. Context: Israel Rejected God's Revelation

- Rom 9:30 What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who **did not pursue righteousness** have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith;
- Ro 10:17 So faith comes from **hearing**, and hearing through the word of Christ. [slide 2]
- 18 But I ask, have they not **heard**? *Indeed they have*, for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." [Ps 19]

- 19 But I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you **jealous** of those who are **not a nation**; ... [Dt 32]
- 20 Then Isaiah is so bold as to say, "I have been found by those who did not seek me; ...21 But of Israel... "All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." [Is 65]

### B. The Rejection is not Total

#### 1. Example: Saul of Tarsus

Ro 11:1 I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For **I myself** am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin.

#### 2. Example: Elijah and the 7000

#### a. Elijah's Complaint: It Looks Bad

11:2 God has not rejected his people whom he *foreknew*. Do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah, how he appeals to God against Israel? **3**"Lord, they have killed your prophets, they have demolished your altars, and **I alone am left**, and they seek my life."

### b. God's Reply: Remnant Chosen by Grace

- 11:4 But what is God's reply to him? "I have **kept for myself** seven thousand men who have not bowed ... to Baal."
- 11:5 So too at the present time *there is a remnant*, **chosen** by **grace**. 6 But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

#### 3. Election & Hardening

11:7 What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened,

#### a. Became de-sensitized

11:8 as it is written, "God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that would not see and ears that would not hear, down to this very day."

### b. BLESSING became snare, trap, stumbling block

11:9 And David says, "Let their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a retribution for them;

#### **Beware of Comfort Zones**

- C. Rejection not Permanent: Pregnant with Purpose
  - 1. Out of Israel's trespass came salvation to the nations!!
  - 2. Salvation in the nations would awaken jealousy in Israel!
  - 11:11 So I ask, did they **stumble** in order that they might **fall? By no means!** Rather, **through** their trespass <u>salvation</u> has come to the Gentiles, so as **to make** Israel jealous.
  - 3. The trespass and failure of Israel released the riches of God's mercies to the world, to the nations.
  - 11:12 Now if **their trespass** *means* riches for the world, and if their **failure** *means* riches for the Gentiles, **how much more** will their **full inclusion** mean! (fullness)
  - 4. How much MORE their fullness?
  - 5. Paul's Deep Desire
  - 11:13\_Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch then as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry 14 in order somehow to make **my fellow Jews** jealous, and thus save some of them.
- D. Israel, the Catalyst
- 11:15 For if their **rejection** means the **reconciliation** of the world, what will their **acceptance** mean but **life from the dead**?

### Rejection -> Reconciliation < Crucifixion>

#### Acceptance —> Life from the Dead <Parousia>

Paul suggests the return of Israel to God's favor will mark the <u>climax</u> of <u>history</u>, when the dead are raised. This ... reference of "life

from the dead" constitutes one important reason to think that Paul is describing a linear sequence of ... salvation history that climax with the return of Christ in glory — Douglas Moo

## **III. The Olive Tree — Warning to Gentile Believers**

### A. Holy Firstfruits and Holy Root

11:16 If the dough offered as **firstfruits** is holy, so is the whole lump, and if the **root** is holy, so are the branches.

Images refer to the patriarchs of Israel.

### B. Warning to the Arrogant Gentile Believer

11:17 But if some of the branches were broken off, and [you], although a **wild olive shoot**, were grafted in among the others and now share in the **nourishing root** of the olive tree, 18 **do not be arrogant** toward the branches. If you are, **remember** it is not [you] who support the root, but **the root that supports [you**].

#### 1. Remember the Source of Salvation

Unusual to graft the wild into the domestic. (Against nature)

#### 2. Avoid Pride with Holy Fear (Awe)

11:19 Then [you] will say, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in." 20 That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but [you] stand fast through faith. So do not become proud, but fear.

#### 3. God is Impartial

11:21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, neither will he spare [you].

#### 4. Behold! Continue...

11:22 Note [Behold!] then the kindness and the severity of God: severity toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness to [you], provided you continue in his kindness. Otherwise [you] too will be cut off. 23 And even

they, **if they do not continue** in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again.

#### 5. Humility and Hope

11:24 For if [you] were cut from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, *how much more* will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree.

## IV. Never Outgrow Mystery!

- A. Partial Hardening ... Until Fullness of the nations
- 11:25 Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
- B. The Promise: All Israel Will be Saved!
- 11:26 And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written, "The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob;" [Is 59]

#### 1. Covenant and removal of sins

11:27 "and this will be my covenant with them when I take away their sins." [Is 27; Jer 31]

### 2. Enemies yet Beloved because of the Patriarchs

11:28 As regards the gospel, they are enemies for your sake. But as regards election, they are beloved for the sake of their forefathers. [Dt 7:8; 10:15]

#### 3. Irrevocable Gifts and Callings!

11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

### 4. Disobedience, Mercy, and God's Plan — JUST AS... SO

11:30 For **just as** you were at one time *disobedient* to God but now have *received mercy* because of *their disobedience*, 31 so they too have now been disobedient <u>in or-</u>

<u>der that</u> by the mercy shown to you they also may now receive mercy.

- 5. We were all Trapped... So that God could show mercy!
- 11:32 For God has **consigned** all to **disobedience**, that he may have mercy on all.

#### Consign — delivered into custody

So that we, by mercy come to the **obedience of faith** 

God *magnified his mercy* by the very fact of disobedience, binding all men over to it (that he might have mercy on all.

Disobedience does not have the last word!

Gal 3:22 But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

# V. Doxology - God's Awesome Purpose & Plan

His ways are beyond our understanding and criticism.

- 11:33 Oh, the depth of the **riches** and **wisdom** and **knowledge** of God! How **unsearchable** are his judgments and how **inscrutable** his ways! [slide 3]
- 34 "For **who** has known the mind of the Lord, or **who** has been his counselor?" 35 "Or **who** has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?"
- 11:36 For <u>from</u> him and <u>through</u> him and <u>to</u> him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen. [slide 4]
