The Law of the Spirit of Life (Rom 8)

I. Gospel Review — Divine Power to Save [slide 1]

Rom. 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is <u>revealed</u> from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

A. Sin & Intervention

(1:18-3:20 A detour to show the need for Christ's intervention)

B. Salvation – (3:21-5:21 Righteousness Imputed)

Explained

Rom. 3:21 But now the **righteousness of God** has been *manifested apart from the law*, ...23 for <u>all have sinned</u> and <u>fall short</u> of the *glory of God*, 24 and are JUSTIFIED by his grace as a gift, through the **redemption** that is in Christ Jesus. [slide 2]

Expressed — Abraham

Rom 4:23 But the words "*it was counted to him*" were not written for his sake alone, 24 but for ours also. It will be <u>counted to us</u> who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord. —>

C. Redemption and Reigning in Life (Rom 5)

Experienced — Peace with God, Hope, Love poured out

1. Redemption's Riches (Rom 5:1-12)

2. Ending the Reign of Death

Rom 5:12 sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, ...14 Yet <u>death reigned</u> from Adam to Moses, ...

3. Reigning in Life

Rom 5:17 For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of

grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man lesus Christ.

III. TRANSFORMATION into His LIKENESS

A. Dead to Sin, Alive to God (Rom 6)

- 6:1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?
- 4 We were **buried** therefore **with him** by baptism **into death**, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in *newness of life*. [slide 3]

KNOW

- 6 We **KNOW** that our old self was **crucified with him** in order that the **body of sin**... **brought to nothing**, ... **NO LONGER** be enslaved to sin.
- **CONSIDER**, RECKON, COUNT
- 11 So you also *must CONSIDER* [reckon, count] yourselves dead to sin and *alive to God* in Christ lesus.

PRESENT, YIELD

- 13 **Do not present** your members to sin ..., but **PRESENT** *yourselves* to God as those who have been brought from **death** to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.
- 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free GIFT of God is eternal life IN Christ Jesus our Lord. [slide 7]

B. Dead to the Law Alive to the Spirit! NEW SYSTEM

- Rom 7:4 Likewise, my brothers, you also have died to the law through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to another, to him who has been raised from the dead, in order that we may bear fruit for God. [slide 8]
- 6 But **now** we are <u>released from the law</u>, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the **Spirit** and not in the old way of the written code. [slide 9]

IV. Freedom — the Law of the Spirit of Life

- Chapter 8 answers the questions raised in 6 & 7. Holy Spirit is the focus and dynamic. No Condemnation —> No Separation (in between there no defeat — more than conquerors).
- **Not a single IMPERATIVE** in the entire chapter. Constant leading of Holy Spirit in the life of the believer.

A. No Condemnation: The Spirit and Law (1 - 4)

- 8:1 There is therefore **now** no condemnation for those who are *in* Christ Jesus. 2 *For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.* [slide 10]
- **Now** The conclusion of Salvation. In THIS age...
- Law like gravity, the governing principle
- selfishness; dishonesty; fear; resentment —> love, humility, truth, forgiveness —> freedom
- 3 For **God has done** what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By **sending** <u>*his own*</u> **Son** in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he **condemned sin in the flesh**,
- God has done it! His OWN Son... NIV for a "sin offering"
- Condemned sin ... condemned, not occuppied, to be demolished
- 4 in order that <u>the righteous requirement of the law might be</u> <u>fulfilled in us</u>, <u>who walk</u> not according to the flesh but <u>according to the Spirit</u>.
- **Fulfilled** in **us** (3:31 we uphold the law) light of the world, salt of the earth

According to --- under relational influence

B. No Obligation: Flesh, Spirit, Adoption (5-17)

- Ro 8:5 For those who live (lit. EXIST) according to the flesh set their **minds** on the things of the flesh, but <u>those who</u> <u>live according to the Spirit</u> set their **minds** on the things of the Spirit. 6 For to set the **mind** on the flesh is death, but <u>to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace</u>. 7 For the **mind** that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it <u>does not submit</u> to God's law; indeed, it <u>cannot</u>. 8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.
- 9 You, however, are NOT <u>in</u> the flesh but <u>in the Spirit</u>, if in fact the <u>Spirit of God dwells in you</u>. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. 10 But if <u>Christ is in you</u>, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is ζωή life because of righteousness. 11 <u>If the Spirit</u> of him who <u>raised Jesus</u> from the dead <u>dwells in</u> <u>you</u>, he who <u>raised Christ Jesus</u> from the dead will also <u>give life to your mortal bodies</u> through his <u>Spirit who</u> <u>dwells in</u> you.
- Body subject to death (mortal)
- The Holy Spirit GIVES LIFE to our mortal bodies (makes them alive with divine life), immortally alive.
- THE COSMIC WAR IS WON BY ADOPTION (Ps 2)
- 12 So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. 13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live (supernaturally "already —not yet"). 14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ,

provided we **suffer** with him in order that we may also be **glorified** with him. <u>INDIVISIBLE INHERITANCE</u>

Gal 4:7 No longer a slave, but a son.

SONS — ADOPTION — Hebrews 1; Phil 2; Ps 2:7-9

C. No Separation: The Spirit and the Struggle (18-39)

No one and nothing is able to separate us from the love of <u>Christ!</u>

No condemnation now I dread, Jesus, and *all* in Him, is mine! Alive in Him, my living Head, And clothed in righteousness divine, Bold I approach th' eternal throne, And claim the crown, thru Christ my own. Amazing love! how can it be That Thou, my God, shouldst die for me?

V. Application — the Law of the Spirit of Life

Live According to the Spirit; Mind on the Spirit —>Life & Peace

No obsession w/ frustration and futility swirling around;

fear; selfishness; dishonesty; fear; resentment —> love, humility, truth, forgiveness —> freedom

Delight in the Promises of God that found their YES in Christ

Ps 1; 2 Pet 1 Great & Precious Promises
