# II. Timing

<u>Galatians 4:4–5</u> (ESV)But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,

to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

## A. Fullness of Time

### A. His Presence Transforms

#### **Matt 1:23 ESV**

"Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).

# B. Immanuel...God with *Us*

Not just "God made us."

Not just "God thinks of us"

Not just God "above us."

But God WITH us, where we are.

In the office, kitchen, on the plane. He breathed our air and walked the same earth.

### Darkness starts to tremble ... At the light that You bring

## IV. He Seeks Us!

### A. Darkness Trembles

The troubled, dark EMPEROR brings about God's Plan

#### **Luke 2:1-7 NLT**

At that time the Roman emperor, Augustus, decreed that a census should be taken throughout the Roman Empire.

(This was the first census taken when Quirinius was governor of Syria.)

All returned to their own ancestral towns to register for this census.

And because Joseph was a descendant of King David, he had to go to Bethlehem in Judea, David's ancient home. He traveled there from the village of Nazareth in Galilee.

He took with him Mary, to whom he was engaged, who was now expecting a child.

And while they were there, the time came for her baby to be born.

She gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him snugly in strips of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no lodging available for them.

## B. Glory Invades

Luke 2:8–9 ESV And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear.

## 1. Great (mega) Fear!

And when You walk into the room

Every heart starts burning

And nothing matters more
Than just to sit here at Your feet
And worship You

Lk 2:10 ESVAnd the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.

## C. THE Promise - Savior and King

Luke 2:11 ESV For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

#### **Unto YOU!**

Everyday People

### Born – God's face...just getting started

### **This** Day

Specific time

### In the city of David

Specific location

#### Savior

Specific mission — Rescue, Restore, Renew

#### Christ, Messiah

Specific Person — Messiah - the Seed of Abraham

#### Lord

 $Specific\ purpose\ -A\ new\ ruler\ -Kyrios, Lord!\ (Caesar)$ 

#### **Specific Sign that He Came to Save**

Luke 2:12 ESVAnd this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger."

Shepherds who cared for the temple lambs understood this. When a male lamb without defect, suitable for sacrifice, was born the shepherds would wrap the lamb in clean cloth. It set them apart.

## D. Suddenly Worship!

### 1. Massive Army of Worshippers

Luke 2:13–14 ESV And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying,

"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!"

### **Angels and Worship**

Rev 5:11–12 NKJV Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands,

saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

### 3. Impact of Worship

#### Mission

Luke 2:16–17 ESV And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger.

And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child.

#### Wonder

Luke 2:17–18 ESV And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child.

And all who heard it wondered at what the shepherds told them.

#### Mary Treasured

Luke 2:19 ESV But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart.

### **Shouting and Praise!**

Luke 2:20 ESV And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.

# VI. Naming the Promised One

Luke 2:21 ESV And at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

The One Who named every star at creation,

Named by His mother and adoptive father.

Psalm 147:4 NLT He counts the stars and calls them all by name.

## VII. Seek and Find

Luke 2:22 NKJV. Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present *Him* to the Lord

The Incarnate Word is 6 weeks old. The one who determined the number of the stars, now has the days counted before he can enter the Temple built by Herod.

The days were completed (fulfilled). 8 plus 33 days...

## A. Simeon - the godly Seeker

Luke 2:25–26 ESV Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Eagerly EXPECTING the Consolation of Israel, God's Promise (Messiah), the **HELP** Holy Spirit had REVEALED that he would see MESSIAH before he died.

# B. That Day - Timing

Luke 2:27–28 NLT That day the Spirit led him to the Temple. So when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required,

Simeon was there. He took the child in his arms and praised God, saying,

## THAT DAY...Holy Spirit led him

SO WHEN... Mary and Joseph came

SIMEON WAS THERE!

HE TOOK ... Child in his arms and

## PRAISED GOD WITH A SONG

Luke 2:29-32 NLT

"Sovereign Lord, now let your servant die in peace, as you have promised.

I have seen your salvation,

which you have prepared for all people.

He is a light to reveal God to the nations, and he is the glory of your people Israel!"

Now ... SHALOM

Seen SALVATION

Prepared ... all people ... Barbarians.. Romans.. Jews...

Light for the Gentiles ... declared in the Temple

Glory for your people Israel.

Great anticipation that every promise of God finding its YES in Christ.
