### II. Habakkuk's Process

## A. The Difficulty with Evil

Increased turmoil, rising terrorism, mounting tragedies, unprecedented trauma, increasing pollution, deepening trials, and unparalleled tensions cast dark shadows over earthlings. The world looks more and more like some ominous black sphere with a very short fuse, a time bomb sizzling to explode.

Why is there so much oppression? Why all the injustice? Why do evil men prosper? Why do the righteous suffer? Why doesn't God do something? Why doesn't God clean up this mess? Why? Why? Why?

- Hab. 1:2 O LORD, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not hear? Or cry to you "Violence!" and you will not save?
- 3 Why do you make me see iniquity, and why do you idly look at wrong? Destruction and violence are before me; strife and contention arise. 4 So the law is paralyzed, and justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround the righteous; so justice goes forth perverted.

### The Response

5 "Look among the nations, and see; wonder and be astounded.
For I am doing a work in your days that you would not believe if told.

[SLIDE 1]

- 6 For behold, I am raising up the Chaldeans, that bitter and hasty nation, who march through the breadth of the earth, to seize dwellings not their own..
- 7 They are dreaded and fearsome; ... 9 They all **come for violence**, ... They **gather captives** like sand ... 11 ... **guilty men, whose own might is their god!**"

### Theological Objection

- 12 Are you not from everlasting, O LORD my God, my Holy One? We shall not die. O LORD, you have ordained them as a judgment, and you, O Rock, have established them for reproof.
- 13 You who are of purer eyes than to see evil and cannot look at wrong, why do you idly look at traitors and remain silent when the wicked swallows up the man more righteous than he?

### **B.** Waiting for the Promises

- Hab. 2:1 I will **take my stand** at my **watchpost** and **station** myself **on the tower**, and **look** out to **see** what he will **say** to me, and what I will answer concerning my complaint.
- 2 And the LORD answered me: "Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it. [SLIDE 2]
- 3 For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens (exhales)\* to the end—it will not lie. If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay. \*It is finished [SLIDE 2]
- Hab. 2:4 "Behold, his soul is puffed up; it is not upright within him, but *the righteous shall live by his faith.* (ba—in, at)
- **Heb 10:36** For you have <u>need of endurance</u>, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. 37 For, "Yet a little while,
  - and the coming one will come and will not delay;
- but *my righteous one shall live by faith*, (ek–out of) and if he shrinks back. (LXX)

my soul has no pleasure in him."

Heb. 10:39 But we are not <u>of those</u> who shrink back and are destroyed, but <u>of those</u> who have faith and preserve their souls.

This issue is "fall apart" or be "made whole" (to the saving of the soul)

- 11:1 *Now faith is* the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
- 3 By faith we understand that <u>the universe was created by the word</u> <u>of God</u>, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

### Retribution for EVIL - delayed but inevitable

Hab. 2:9 "Woe to him who gets evil gain for his house, t...

11 For the stone will cry out from the wall, and the beam from the woodwork respond.

# **DISPLACEMENT OF EVIL – evil is temporary REWARD ETERNAL** [SLIDE 3]

14 For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

### C. Hearing the Report of the Lord

- Hab. 3:2 O LORD, I have **heard** the report of you, and your work, O LORD, do I fear. In the midst of the years revive it; in the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy.
- NIV LORD, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, O LORD. Renew them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.

- 3 God came from Teman, and the Holy One from Mount Paran.

- 16 <u>I hear</u>, and my body trembles; my lips quiver at the sound; rottenness enters into my bones; my legs tremble beneath me. Yet I will quietly wait for the day of trouble to come upon people who invade us.
