Make the Nations Glad

I. Spreading the Joy — Impact of Blessing

A. Abraham and Blessing

Gen 12.1 Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. 2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

IN YOU & in your offspring

- Gen 22.18 and in your offspring shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice." Gal. 3.
- Gal 3:8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." 9 So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.
- 16 Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring. It does not say, "And to offsprings," referring to many, but **referring to one**, "And to your offspring," who is **Christ**. ... 18 For if **the inheritance comes** by the law, it no longer comes by promise; but God gave it to Abraham **by a promise**.
- Lessons about true worship are timeless: (1) Faith obeys completely. (2) Faith surrenders the best, holding nothing back. (3) Faith waits on the Lord to provide all one's needs. True worship is costly.

Global Impact of missions

C. Personal Transformation

We were created for Communion with God into Freedom & Love

A Process of the Heart:

- 1.Receive the Love that the Holy Spirit pours into our Hearts. This produces a change in motivation, a sanctification that makes us like him in this world.
- 2. This *love opens our eyes*, allowing us to see the intrinsic value that our Father places upon our lives, our souls. We can love what God loves. It *sanctifies us* as the Word of God brings coherence into our being. Love purifies us of anxiety, anger, fear, worry. The Word of God releases us into love, appreciation and compassion.
- 3. This love shines from us as **we love our neighbor with the same love. We now become the delivery system of the New Creation,** an unstoppable, perpetually regenerated community of lovers that will fill the earth. This is the mission of every believer, and the mission of the Church.

II. Blessing the Nations

A. The Incarnation Changes Cultures!

- One thousand years ago, the Islamic civilization had surpassed Europe in nearly every respect. Islamic rulers were wealthier, Islamic armies were more powerful, and Islamic intellectuals had advanced further in the arts, scholarship, science, and technology.
- Something changed. Now, the people of Spain translate as many books into Spanish each year as Arabs have translated into Arabic in the last thousand years.

- If you take oil out of the equation, the 5 million people of **Finland** export more goods and services each year than the 165 million of the Arab world.
- Oil **British** discovered the oil in the Middle East, **American** companies began pumping and refining it, the production of oil is sustained by engineers recruited from the **Western** world.
- What brought about this dramatic rise of the West while the rest of the world stagnated? The Glorious Gospel propelled by voluntary generosity of believers and missionaries.

B. The Worth of a Human & Incarnation

Human **dignity** is established by the incarnation of Christ.

Islam denies God the capacity to become a human.

Far from violating God's dignity, the incarnation was to be the **ultimate proof of God's kindness & man's dignity**: of the possibility of a man or a woman becoming a child of God.

God's descent means man's ascent!

C. Transformation of Nations. [Slide 3]

1. Music – Pipe Organs [Slide 4]

In the tenth century AD, Augustine's biblical philosophy of music inspired a group of Benedictine monks to build the world's largest pipe organ in the cathedral of **Winchester**, **England**. The organ required **70 men and 26 bellows to supply wind to its 400 pipes**. Technologically, the pipe organ was the world's most advanced machine until the invention of the mechanical clock.

Europe's organs stood as emblems of the West's unique desire and ability to use the arts, science, and technology for the glory of God as well as for the relief of humanity's suffering and toil.


