I. The Word of the Father - Begotten Before All Ages

- John 1:1 NIV In the beginning was the **Word**, and the **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning.
- 3 **Through him all things were made**; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 **In him was life**, and that **life** was the **light of men**. 5 The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not **understood [grasp-master]** it.
- 9 The true **light** that gives light to every man was **coming into the** world. ei[•]B to\n ko/smon
- 10 He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not **recognize** [experience] him. 11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not **receive** him. 12 Yet to all who **received** him, to those who **believed** in his name, he gave the right to become children of God —
- 14 The **Word became flesh** and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his **glory**, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- 16 From the fullness of his grace we have all received one blessing after another [grace upon grace]. 17 For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
- Jer 33:14 NKJV "Behold, the days are coming,' says the LORD, 'that I will perform that good thing (Heb. Dabar Tov) which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah: 'when I will fulfill the gracious promise' (NIV)
- 15 "In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David A Branch of righteousness;

He shall execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

 In those days Judah will be saved, And Jerusalem will dwell safely.
And this *is the name* by which she will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.'

II. The Good Word We Speak (Word - Light)

- Prov 12:25 ESV Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down, but a **good word** makes him **glad**.
- Prov 16:24 NIV Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.
- Prov 18:21 NIV The tongue has the power of **life** and **death**, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
- Deut 30:14 NKJV But the **word** *is* **very near you**, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it.
- 15 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil,
- 19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; there-fore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; "

III. The Good Word We Fulfill

- John 5:24 NIV "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has *crossed over from death to life*.
- 1 John 3:14 NKJV We know that we have **passed from death** to **life**, because we **love the brethren**. He who does not love *his* brother **abides in death**.

IV. The Word That Reorders the Universe

Isa 9:1 NIV Nevertheless, there will be **no more gloom** for those who were in distress. ... 2 The people walking in darkness have

seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death **a light has dawned**.

- 3 You have **enlarged** the nation and **increased their joy**; they **rejoice** before you as people **rejoice** at the harvest, as men rejoice when dividing the plunder.
- 4 For as in the day of Midian's defeat, you have shattered the **yoke** that burdens them, the **bar** across their shoulders, the **rod** of their oppressor.
- 5 **Every** warrior's boot used in battle and every garment rolled in blood will be destined for **burning**, will be **fuel** for the **fire**.
- 6 For to us a **child is born**, to us a **son is given**, and the **government** will be on his shoulders.
