Haggai 2:7 (ESV)

And I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in (*speaking of global worship, worship from every nation*). And I will fill this house (*that's you!*) with glory, says the Lord of hosts. (*often shaking leads to filling*).

How do we access more? What's a key that unlocks this door and keeps it open?

HUMILITY: The Awareness of Our Need for God SLIDE

James 4:5-8 (ESV)

Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, “He yearns jealously over the spirit that He has made to dwell in us”? But He gives more grace. Therefore, it says, “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”

I think one of the most powerful definitions (or the most powerful definition) of humility is the awareness of our great need for God. Our essential need for God. He gives grace to the humble. Grace for what? So that His Spirit (that He made to dwell in us) would come! And dwell in us.

8 Submit yourselves therefore to God. (*Submission is humility in action*). Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. **Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you.** *What a promise.*

2 Chronicles 7:14 (ESV)

If my people who are called by my name **humble themselves**, and pray and **seek my face** (*some translations say seek or desire My Presence*) and turn from their wicked ways...

Wicked way...

Turn from all other sources of life that are inadequate, empty, and lead to destruction and chaos. Even a turning away from my own desire to run the show...letting go of the belief that I can be my own source of life and strength. That I don't need Him.

Aren't you thankful for His Presence, that comes with mercy and grace to remind us how much we need Him...this is conviction...this is what leads us to receive the gift of repentance...

Repentance isn't just about turning away from...it's about turning towards Him!

Turning towards the One true life comes from. Turning towards real power, real love! True life!

Then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

...Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Matthew 5:3 (ESV)

Blessed are the **poor in spirit**, for theirs is the **Kingdom of Heaven.**

It is easy to misinterpret this verse; "poor in spirit" does not mean depressed, discouraged, or weary. (It's more about hunger and thirst!)

To become poor in spirit means to become aware of my vast absolute, never-ending NEED for God! Recognizing my own spiritual bankruptcy, understanding my complete dependence on His mercy and grace. That without Him, I am nothing, I have nothing, I can do nothing! I didn't even bring anything to the table to this relationship! In fact, I love Him because He first loved me...even the love I have for Him, came from Him! Realizing He doesn't fit into my life! I was made to fit into His!

To become poor in spirit is to recognize my ever-present need for His Presence!

And what does Jesus say...

“BLESSED are the POOR IN SPIRIT for YOURS IS THE KINGDOM!”

Where is this, Kingdom?!

Romans 14:17 (ESV)

For the **Kingdom of God** is not a matter of eating and drinking but of **righteousness and peace and joy (abundant life!) IN THE HOLY SPIRIT.**

It's all about the Holy Spirit. It's all about His Presence. When we encounter the Holy Spirit, we encounter His Kingdom! On the poor in spirit, He pours out His Spirit.

The awareness of our great need for Him so often becomes the pathway that leads to encounter.

Our continual revelation, our continual desperation becomes the invitation to encounter more! A greater measure. A greater outpouring of His Spirit.

Ephesians 3:16-21 TPT

"Living Water"

John 7:37-39 (ESV)

On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, "If anyone **thirsts**, let him **come to Me and drink**. Whoever believes in me as the Scripture has said, **'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'** *Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive,"*

The only requirement (the only qualifier!) to come and drink is **THIRST**.

What is Jesus saying...if you are THIRSTY come to ME and DRINK. I guarantee you, that I am the One you are looking for! I am the desire of your heart. I am the giver of true life! I have living water!

DRINKING IS BELIEVING

Jesus is saying YOUR FAITH IN ME is an EXPERIENTIAL FAITH! This is why David sang, "Taste and see that the Lord is good!" This is why I say, COME to ME and DRINK! (This is why you must EAT MY BODY! DRINK MY BLOOD!)

EXPERIENCE ME! ENCOUNTER ME FOR YOURSELF! I WILL FILL YOU WITH
ABUNDANT LIFE!

And whoever believes (comes to faith in this way!) from His innermost being will flow continual
(AMP) rivers of living water!

In the Kingdom a drink becomes a river.

In the Kingdom encounters with the living God become a rivers of living water.
