II. Seeing and Not Seeing.

A. Elisha and Two Kings

2 Kings 6:8 Once when the **king of Syria** (**Ben-Hadad**) was warring against Israel, he took counsel with his servants, saying, "At such and such a place shall be my camp." 9 But the **man of God** sent word to the king of Israel, "Beware that you do not pass this place, for the Syrians are going down there." 10 And the king of Israel sent to the place... so that he saved himself there more than once or twice.

King of Syria – a traitor? No, Elisha in Dothan

14 So he sent there horses and chariots and a great army, and they came by night and surrounded the city.

SFFING ABUNDANCE

15 When the servant of the man of God rose early in the morning and went out, behold, an army with horses and chariots was all around the city. And the servant said, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" 16 He said, "Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." 17 Then Elisha prayed and said, "O Lord, please open his eyes that he may see." So the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw, and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. 18 And when the Syrians came down against him, Elisha prayed to the Lord and said, "Please strike this people with blindness." So he struck them with blindness in accordance with the prayer of Elisha.

SEEING AN UNEXPECTED OPPORTUNITY

- 19 And Elisha said to them, "This is not the way, and this is not the city. Follow me, and I will bring you to the man whom you seek." And he led them to Samaria. (12 miles)
- 20 As soon as they entered Samaria, Elisha said, "O Lord, open the eyes of these men, that they may see." So the

Lord opened their eyes and they saw, and behold, they were in the midst of Samaria.

DEALING WITH PANIC (STINKING THINKING)

21 As soon as the **king of Israel (Joram) saw** them, he said to Elisha, "My father, **shall I** strike them down? **Shall I** strike them down?" 22 He answered, "**You shall not** strike them down. Would you strike down those whom you have taken captive with your sword and with your bow? **Set bread and water before them,** that they may eat and drink and go to their master."

BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS

23 So he prepared for them a great feast, and when they had eaten and drunk, he sent them away, and they went to their master. And the Syrians did not come again on raids into the land of Israel.

B. Wickedness in High Places; A HIGHER PLACE!

Psalm 2:1 **Why** do the nations **rage** and the **peoples plot** in vain?

2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against his Anointed, saying,

3 "Let us **burst** their bonds apart

et us **burst** their bonds apart and **cast away** their cords from us."

4 He who sits in the heavens **laughs**; the Lord holds them in **derision**.

- 5 Then he will speak to them in his wrath, (Rom 1:18) and terrify them in his fury, saying,
- 6 "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill."
- 7 I will tell of the decree:

The Lord said to me, "You are my Son;

today I have begotten you.

- 8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.
- 12c **Blessed** are all who take refuge in him.

III. Come Learn Receive Find-

A. WEARY, HEAVY LADEN

Matt 11:28 Come **to me**, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will **give you rest**. [SLIDE 1]

REST - LOVE GIVES ITSELF RECEIVING

Isa 30:15 ... "In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength."

WALKING LEARNING TRANSFORMATION FINDING

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. STEWARD

30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

IV. PRAYING FROM PEACE; VOTING FOR LIFE

A. Our Free Response - Return to the State of Joy

Hope —> Joy.

Anger — Frustration —> CONTEMPT (beneath consideration)

RETURN TO LOVE — FULL SHARING

1 Jn 4:16 So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever **abides** in love **abides** in God, and God **abides** in him. 17 **By this** is love perfected with us, so that we may have **confidence for**

- **the day of judgment,** because **as he is** so also are we in this world.
- 18 There is **no fear in love**, but **perfect love casts out fear**. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. NO ROOM FOR FEAR. [SL 2]
- 19 We love because he first loved us. [SL 3]

B. What Shall We Say?

To bad news?

Ro 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

To being dissed, cursed, called names?

34 Who is to **condemn**? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. [SL 4]

To feeling abandoned?

35 Who shall **separate us from the love** of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or **persecution**, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?

To being mistreated?

36 As it is written,

"For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."

DECLARE and DECREE

37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

[SL 5]38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
