- John 19:15 ESV ... "Shall I crucify your King?" The chief priests answered, **"We have no king but Caesar."**
- Heb 2:14 NIV Since the children have flesh and blood, he too <u>shared in their humanity</u> so that by his death he might <u>destroy</u> him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil— 15 and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.
- At 32 John Paton accepted the call to missionary service in the New Hebrides in the South Pacific. In March 1858 he married Mary Ann Robson, and on April 16 they sailed together for the cannibal island of Tanna. (Today Vanuatu - a Christian Nation)
- In less than a year they had built a little home and Mary had given birth to a son. But on March 3, 1859, one year after their marriage, Mary died of the fever, and in three weeks the infant son died. John Paton buried them alone, and wrote, "But for Jesus ... I must have gone mad and died beside that lonely grave."
- One of the gifts that Jesus had given him to sustain him in those days were the words his wife spoke shortly before here death. She did not murmur against God, or resent her husband bringing her there. Rather she spoke these incredible words — "I do not regret leaving home and friends. If I had it to do over, I would do it with more pleasure, yes, with all my heart"

Every claim against humanity – cancelled!

Col 2:13 ESV And you, who were dead in your trespasses ..., God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, 14 by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.
15 He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

2. Tendency to Look For Things Which No Longer Exist

Luke 24:5 NIV In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? 6 He is not here; he has risen! Remember ... 8 Then they remembered his words.

3. The Tendency to Panic

John 20:2 NIV [Mary Magdalene] came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, "*They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!"*

4. Tendency to Get Stuck in Loss

- 11 but Mary stood outside the tomb crying.
- 15 "Woman," he said, "<u>why</u> are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?" Thinking he was the gardener, she said, "Sir, if you have carried him away, *tell me where you have put him,* and I will get him."
- 16 Jesus said to her, "**Mary**." She turned toward him and cried out in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher).

6. Tendency to Disappointment ~ "It's Over"

- Luke 24:21 NIV but **we had hoped** that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel. And what is more, it is the third day since all this took place. **MIRACLES**
- 31 <u>Then their eyes were opened</u> and they recognized him, and <u>he</u> <u>disappeared</u> from their sight. 32 They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

7. Survivalism — "We're Next!"

- John 20:19 NIV On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the *doors locked for fear of the Jews*, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "*Peace* be with you!" 20:20 After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were *overjoyed* when they **saw** the Lord.
- (Luke 24:41 ...they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" 42 They gave him a piece of broiled fish, 43 and he took it and ate it in their presence.)
- 21 Again Jesus said, "**Peace** be with you! As the **Father** has **sent** me, **I** am sending you." 22 And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."
